Overview

Arkansas State University ranks 87 out of 257 schools in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings. It earns a score of 60 and a D- speech climate grade. The university fell 29 places from last year, and its policies still earn a "yellow light" Spotlight rating.

Arkansas State places in the top 25 for both "Disruptive Conduct" and "Political Tolerance," and in the top 50 for "Comfort Expressing Ideas." Yet Arkansas State also ranks in the bottom 50 for "Openness," indicating that many topics remain difficult to broach in class or social settings.

Arkansas State could improve by revising its written speech policies to earn a "green light" Spotlight rating, adopting a free speech statement based on the Chicago Statement, and adopting an official commitment to institutional neutrality.
