Overview

Colorado State University ranks 113 out of 257 schools in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings, earning a score of 58, an F speech climate grade. Its policies still earn a “yellow light” Spotlight rating.

Student perceptions show pockets of support. CSU places in the top 50 for “Administrative Support.” At the same time, the school remains in the bottom 50 for “Self-Censorship,” indicating many hesitate to share controversial views.

CSU could improve by revising its written speech policies to earn a “green light” Spotlight rating, adopting a free speech statement based on the Chicago Statement, and adopting an official commitment to institutional neutrality.

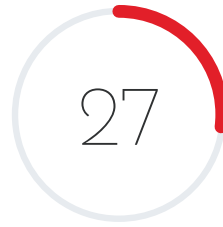
HIGHLIGHTS
