## Overview

Wayne State University ranks 126 out of 257 schools in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings. The drop from last year coincided with a penalty tied to campus police halting a pro-Palestinian vigil that administrators had previously approved.

Students report lower scores across the survey compared to last year's responses except for "Disruptive Conduct," where more students now find attempts to stop speakers less acceptable. Wayne State places in the top 50 for both "Comfort Expressing Ideas" and "Openness" to tough conversations. These strengths were outweighed by a persistent "yellow light" Spotlight rating and the absence of both the Chicago Statement and institutional neutrality.

Wayne State could improve by revising its written speech policies to earn a "green light" Spotlight rating, as well as adopting the Chicago Statement and an official commitment to institutional neutrality.
