## Overview

North Dakota State University ranks 114 out of 257 schools in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings, earning a score of 58, an F speech climate grade. The university still earns a “yellow light” Spotlight rating and has not adopted the Chicago Statement or an official commitment to institutional neutrality.

Student perceptions place NDSU in the top 50 for “Disruptive Conduct,” indicating relatively strong rejection of shout-downs and similar tactics compared to other schools.

NDSU could make immediate progress by revising its speech policies to earn a “green light” Spotlight rating, formally adopting the Chicago Statement and an official commitment to institutional neutrality – as well as clarifying administrative backing for peaceful debate.”
