Overview

Making its debut in the rankings, Middle Tennessee State University ranks 15 out of 257 schools in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings, earning a score of 72 and a C- speech climate grade. Its strong performance is bolstered by a "green light" Spotlight rating and adoption of the Chicago Statement, which together signal clear institutional support for free expression.

Student perceptions, however, present a mixed picture. MTSU places in the top 50 for "Political Tolerance," indicating comparatively greater willingness to host speakers from across the ideological spectrum. At the same time, the university lands in the bottom 50 on "Openness," suggesting many students hesitate to discuss certain controversial issues.

MTSU could strengthen its free speech culture further by adopting an official commitment to institutional neutrality and facilitating programs that encourage substantive dialogue on difficult topics.
